 - Acts which violate the peace and safety of the community in which the place of the business is located, including, but not limited to: patrons causing a disturbance and fighting in the parking lot; patrons standing in the roadway while leaving the establishment; gunshots reported coming from the area of the establishment; allowing the Board to take action "for any reason to promote the peace and safety of the community in which the premises are located" in violation of Section 4-604(A)(1) of The Alcohol Beverage Article of the Maryland Annotated Code and "for any cause which, in the judgment of the Board, is necessary to promote the peace and safety of the community in which the place of business is situated" in violation of Section 5.01 of the Rules and Regulations of the Alcohol Beverage Board of St. Mary's County.
