The 2013 Piney Point preservation work was completed by Mediterranean Construction Co., Inc., of Baltimore, Maryland.

**2013** presented the museum division staff with hard-earned successes in almost every project and event we took on. For the first time in 10 years, the staff and volunteers adjusted 5 major events to accommodate weather conditions: snow for the Appraiser Fair and Maryland Day; and rain for the St. Clement's Island Heritage Day, the Potomac Jazz and Seafood Festival and the Piney Point 10-mile run. Did the circumstances dampen any spirits or deter participation? Not at all! Workers and participants went straight to plan "B" and record numbers of participants enjoyed the museum's offerings as much as ever!

The preservation work on the 1836 Piney Point lighthouse and keeper's quarters was a huge project. As the work progressed, diverse structural issues were uncovered creating many unexpected challenges and yards of red tape. However the project's outcome is a "site" to behold. The structures' exteriors are in exceptional condition and the buildings have been restored to a breathable condition which we hope will drastically limit future damage due to water wicking through the masonry damaging all the other building materials.

We thank all of our museum division partners and visitors for their loyal support through wind, rain and construction this past year! We look forward to seeing you in 2014.

## Mission Statement

The St. Mary's County Museum Division was instituted by the St. Mary's County Board of County Commissioners to collect, preserve, research and interpret the historic sites and artifacts that illustrate the natural and cultural histories of St. Clement's Island and the Potomac River, the Piney Point Lighthouse and the Chesapeake Bay, and the Drayden African American and Charlotte Hall schoolhouses. With this as its charter, the Museum Division serves as a resource, liaison and community advocate for all St. Mary's County public and private cultural assets.

## Overview of Facilities

The St. Mary's County Museum Division manages 94 acres of property and 4 historic sites, including: St. Clement's Island Museum and the Charlotte Hall Schoolhouse; the Piney Point Lighthouse, Museum and Historic Park; the Drayden African American Schoolhouse; and the U-1105 Underwater Submarine Shipwreck Preserve near Piney Point Park. The Museum Division also assists with the monitoring and maintenance of St. Clement's Island State Park.

Also in the Museum Division's care are:

- 6 historic buildings including the Piney Point Lighthouse; Piney Point Lighthouse Keepers' Quarters; the Piney Point Lighthouse Fuel Building; the 1943 U.S. Navy Workshop Building; the Drayden African American Schoolhouse; and the Charlotte Hall Schoolhouse.
- 7 contemporary support buildings; 4 public piers; a kayak launch; an outreach van, staff car, and a water taxi.

## 2013 Restoration Work Completed

The major project of the year was the completion of the restoration of the masonry, windows, wood work, and metal work on the Piney Point lighthouse tower, keeper's quarters and fuel building. The focus was on the exterior of the buildings but great effort was applied to resolving the moisture issues, and restoring the interior masonry of the lighthouse tower. Mediterranean Construction Co., Inc. of Baltimore, Maryland provided the skill and craftsmanship for the project.

Both schoolhouses continue to be monitored and pest management maintained.

## 2013 Capital Improvements

### Piney Point Improvements:

- Visitor entry and museum store were remodeled and painted.
- UV film was applied to the museum store and visitor entry windows and doors
- Native plant gardens were installed
- A site signage plan was developed, fabricated and installed
- The parking lot pavement was lined for safe entry and exit
- Keeper's Quarters sump pump were rerouted to empty into the rain garden
- The Potomac River Maritime Exhibit Building underwent electrical upgrades
- Museum entry flag pole was installed to help designate the visitor services building

### St. Clement's Island Museum:

- New guttering was installed on the main museum building
- A new well was drilled for the Annex complex
- The state pier was completely over hauled by DNR
