Inclement Weather Policy

Cancellation:

A decision will be made by 7:45 a.m. the morning of the day in question. Typically camp will be cancelled for heavy rain.

All cancellations are listed on the information/cancellation line 737-5681 or 5680. You may also call the main office between the hours of 8:00a.m. -5:00p.m. Monday-Friday at 301-4200 ext. Radio Stations 98.3 and 97.7 will list all of the Recreation and Parks cancellations.

If the camp has already begun, students will call a parent for immediate pick up. Camp will be cancelled if heavy rain begins, thunder or lightning. In the case of thunder and lightning the participants will be moved into a facility until they are picked up.

If two of the last three days of the week are missed only one of those days will be made up on Tuesday rain or shine.

TENNIS CAMP: Monday July 11th from 4:00a.m. to 6:00p.m. for the first class and 6:00p.m. to 8:00p.m. for the second class.

TENNIS CLASS: You may attend another session on another day.

Refunds:

Inclement weather refunds will only be given when two or more full days are cancelled and are not able to be made up. If this occurs your price will be pro-rated per day and refunds will be mailed to your home address within two-weeks.

A full refund may be obtained if the Department of Recreation and Parks changes the location, time or date of the program, which prohibits attendance or if the Department cancels the program due to insufficient registration.

A full refund may be obtained, due to a medical problem verified by a doctor's certificate, if a request is issued in writing the Friday, prior to the camp start date.

A refund minus a \$15 service charge may be obtained if the refund is requested in writing one week prior to the first day of camp.

A partial refund may be obtained after the registrant has attended only one day of camp. The registrant must submit the request in writing and will be allowed the refund minus a \$15.00 service charge in addition to one day pro-rated cost. (I.e.: registration fee is \$65 one day is worth \$14 – total refund is \$42)

Refunds will not be given to any participant who has attended two or more days of camp.

St. Mary's County Recreation & Parks Sports Camp Information 2011

Welcome to St. Mary's County Recreation and Parks, Recreation Division Summer Sports Camps. There is a fun filled and busy week planned for your child (ren). The Department would like to address some pre-camp matters that will make your camp experience more enjoyable.

Sign In and Out Campers:

Parents and or guardians will have to sign their child in and out at the beginning and end of each camp day. An attendance sheet will be attached to a clipboard for everyone to sign. Children may not be dropped off or permitted to walk out to the car. This is for your child's safety. You will also be required to write down on the attendance sheet anyone's name that will NOT BE ALLOWED to pick your child up from camp.

What to Bring:

The following items should be brought with each camper for the following camps:

- Basketball -comfortable clothes-gym shoes
- Baseball - glove, rubber cleats, cap
- Soccer -comfortable clothes, cleats and tennis shoes
- Field Hockey- stick, mouth guard, shin guards, cleats, gym shoes
- Girls Lacrosse -stick, mouth guard, cleats, gym shoes, goggles
- Boys Lacrosse- stick, helmet, gloves, shoulder pads, cleats, gym shoes, mouth piece
- Tennis -racket, can of balls, tennis shoes
- Hitting - glove, cleats, cap
- Softball -glove, cleats, cap
- Volleyball - comfortable clothes, gym shoes
- Cheerleading -comfortable clothes, gym shoes
- Biddy Basketball -comfortable clothes, gym shoes

It is recommended that your child not bring additional personal items to camp such as basketballs and bats. Recreation and Parks is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Medication:

If your child plans to utilize medication during camp you will need to fill out the appropriate paperwork found on the Recreation and Parks website: <http://www.co.saint-marys.md.us/docs/FormK.pdf> form K or call the office at 301-475-4200 xt 1800 for a form to be mailed to you and adhere to the following guidelines:

1. On the appropriate form completely fill in all the necessary information and make sure that your physician's signature where applicable.
2. Bring the completed form with you on the first day of camp.
3. The camp director will keep your form and medication secure and confidential in a lock box stored at camp.
4. All prescription medications and asthma inhalers will be self-administered by your child.
5. Medication must be brought to camp in its original container.
6. Prescription medications and asthma inhalers will not be allowed to be administered during camp hours if you do not plan to abide by these guidelines.

Sunscreen:

Each camper may want to bring his or her own sunscreen.

Breaks:

Water will be made available at each camp. Campers may also want to bring their own bottle of water. During code orange or red day staff will take all necessary precaution to insure proper hydration for your child.

Lunch:

In camp, which has lunch, we strongly urge you to remind your child not to share any portion of their lunch with other campers. This is for your child's own protection. Camps will not provide refrigeration; therefore your child's lunch should be non perishable or brought in a small personal cooler.

Inclement Weather:

A plan is available for each camp. Make sure you receive a copy of the appropriate plan.

Refunds:

Inclement weather refunds will only be given when two or more full days are cancelled. If this occurs your price will be prorated per day and refunds will be mailed to your home address with two weeks.

A full refund may be obtained if the Department of Recreation and Parks changes the location, time or date of the program, which prohibits attendance or if the Department cancels the program due to insufficient registration.

A full refund may be obtained due to a medical problem verified by a doctor's certificate, if a request is issued in writing the Friday prior to the camp start date.

A refund minus a \$15.00 service charge may be obtained if the refund requested in writing, is requested in writing one week prior to the first day of camp.

A partial refund may be obtained after the registrant has attended only one day of camp. The registrant must submit the request in writing and will be allowed the refund minus a \$15.00 service charge in addition to one day pro-rated cost. (I.e.: registration fee is \$65.00; one day is worth \$13.00 – total refund is \$37.00)

Refunds will not be given to any participant who has attended two or more days of camp.
