SUMMARY

Youth sports participation and facility use statistics are vital when addressing needs for park land acquisition, development, and facility usage. This information is necessary for both short and long term requirements. Included in the FY 2010 Youth Sports Participation and Facility Use Report are participation and facility use statistics for Recreation & Parks sponsored and volunteer youth sports leagues. Facility use needs and recommendations provided by Recreation & Parks staff are also included in the report.

The Department sponsors a youth basketball league, which operates in various public schools, as well as indoor soccer, roller hockey, field hockey, and lacrosse leagues at the Leonard Hall Recreation Center. These programs are funded through fees and charges and operate from the Departments' Activity Fund Budget.

GROWTH

At the end of the FY2010 year the decision was made to combine the youth football leagues. The youth football organization is now being run under Recreation and Parks with three divisions (northern, mid-county and southern). RECOMMENDATIONS

Need to move some games to Cecil Park's multipurpose field which is under utilized. This would give a break to the Lancaster fields.

CHALLENGES/ISSUES

- 1.) Need more lit practice spaces
- 2.) Need additional practice space to minimize the usage on private fields to allow for better monitoring of maintenance needs.
