

## Frequently Asked Camp Questions:

**Q. When is the earliest I can register for Summer Camp? What is the last day I can register for Summer Camp?**

A. Summer Camp registration is a first come first serve. Walk In, Mail and On line registration will begin at the Recreation and Parks main office at 23150 Leonard Hall Dr., Leonardtown, MD, on Wednesday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, and will continue through out the summer. Registrations are accepted through walk in (address above) mail in P.O. Box 653, Leonardtown, MD, 20650 or on line at [www.stmarysmd.com/recreate](http://www.stmarysmd.com/recreate) on line registration.

**Q. How do I register online?**

A. Online registration requires an account. If you have used summer camps, child care, gymnastics, swimming lessons, youth or adult leisure programs, indoor sports then you have an “online” account established. An old receipt for a “household number” can be used or call the office at 301-475-4200 x 1800 or send an email from the online site and staff will contact you with your needed information.

If you have never used Recreation and Parks for the above listed programs then open the online page and request an account be established.

**Q. Does Recreation and Parks provide Transportation To and From Camps?**

A. Camp New Horizon, a camp for individuals with disabilities, provides transportation; all other camps are participant provided.

**Q. Are meals provided at camps?**

A. With the exception of Sports Camps both a morning and afternoon snack is provided for all camps.

The New Horizon Camp provides breakfast and lunch for the participants. Camp Inspire provides lunch for participants.

**Q. What do I need to do to guarantee my child a place in camp for the summer?**

A. For the identified recreational camps, a registration form plus \$25 non-refundable deposit for each week registered. The remaining balance is due 3 weeks prior to week of camp registered. Full payment may also be made at time of registration. For all other camps not designated for the \$25 deposit, full payment is required at time of registration.

**Q. Does Recreation and Parks provide the equipment needed for Sports Camps?**

A. No, it is the responsibility of individuals to provide their own equipment.

**Q. Are all the camps inclusive?**

A. Yes, all camps offer supervised activities for children of all abilities. Exception: The New Horizons Camp is for children with special needs only, and Camp Inspire is exclusively for children with Autism Spectrum.

**Q. Are receipts mailed out?**

A. Summer camp receipts are mailed within 5 working days of the registration or emailed (if provided) at the time of registration. A customer has 10 working days to dispute the receipt. If an entry is made incorrectly, simply call the main office and corrections will be made. Errors called in after 10 days will be corrected on space availability. If space is not available, a refund will be provided.
