PROSPECTIVE JUDGES OF ELECTIONS

In order to serve as an Election Judge, you must meet the following requirements:

- Registered Voter in the state of Maryland
- Be physically and mentally capable of working a 15 hour day
(You may not leave the polling place at any time during the Election Day)
- Not be a candidate for or currently hold public or political party office, including Municipal office or party central committee
- Not be a chairman, campaign manger or treasurer for political or candidate Committee

All Election Judges **must** attend a training class prior to their service on Election Day. Election judges are paid for their work.
