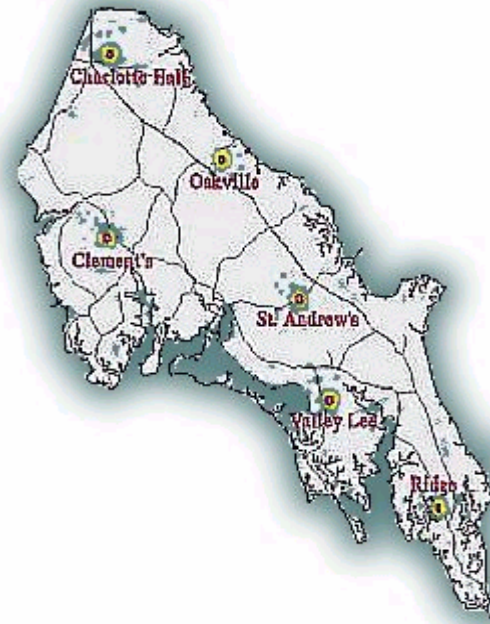


## Reduce

The greatest relief of our solid waste burden can be made by **AVOIDING** waste in the first place. Before you make a purchase, consider the waste you might be creating. Try to buy in bulk (save packaging) or try to buy just enough (so you don't have to discard the last little bit). Can you rent? Can you share?

## Recycle

If you must discard something, you can recycle glass, plastic, steel and aluminum containers, newspapers, magazines, mixed paper, old corrugated cardboard, textiles, rechargeable batteries, inkjet printer cartridges, used motor oil and anti-freeze at the County's six (6) convenience centers. Yard waste, tires, white goods, scrap metal and bulky solid waste are accepted at the St. Andrews Landfill.

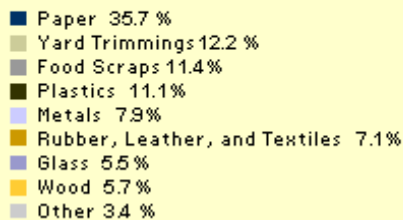
